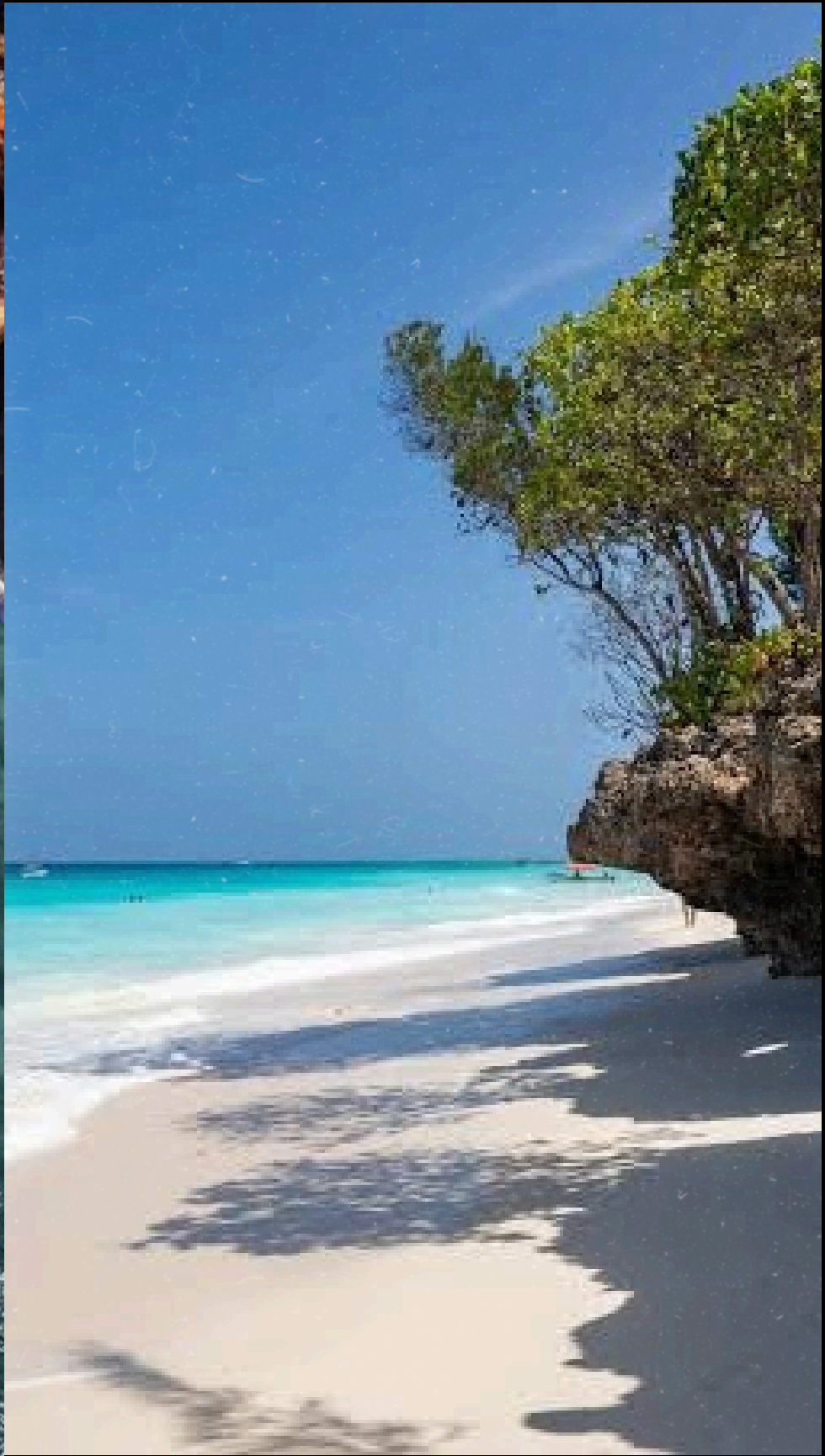
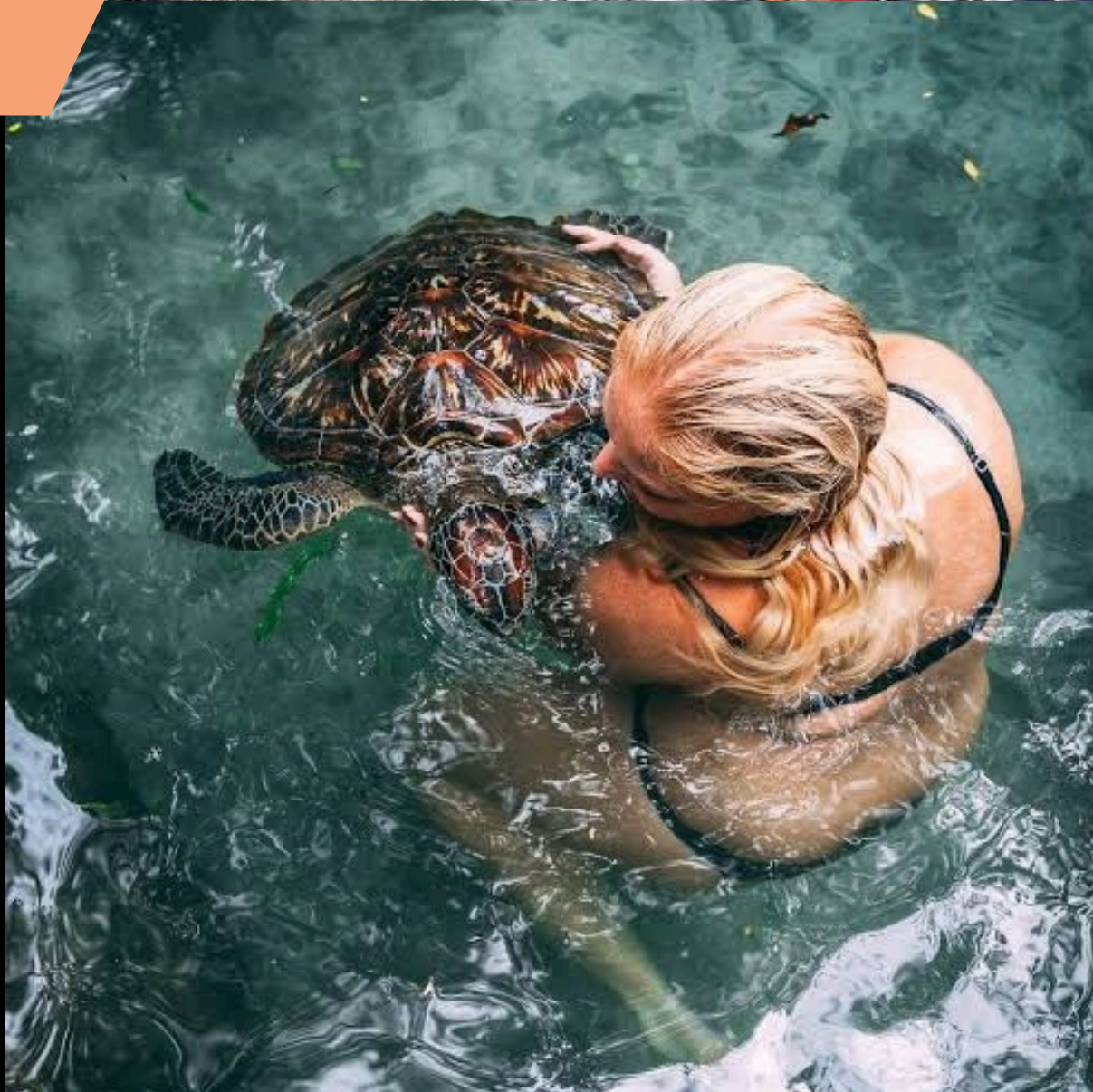
# Jozani forest tour & salami aquarium





To enter the island you need special permission from the elders. The Watumbatu – inhabitants of Tumbatu - are living as a very close, self-supporting community. Many of them have never been on Unguja. You won't find cars or scooters there; Tumbatu has only one road to walk on, even though this is the place where in the 11th century the Shirazi built the first stone building in the entire Zanzibar
